(NOTE: The APA Publication Manual uses hanging indents and italics while The Writer's FAQs uses paragraph indents and underlining. Check with individual professors as to preference.)

**Examples have titles italicized to conform to the APA Publication Manual.**

**Everything that is in italics can be underlined to conform to The Writer's FAQs, but note, indenting is reversed.**
