Early Registration Procedures

1. All students must see their advisor and have a signed *Registration Form* to register.
2. Take your *Registration Form* to the Student Life Office for information updates and Dean of Students approval before going to the Financial Services Office and the Registrar's Office.
3. Take your *Registration Form* to the Financial Services Office for financial aid and student accounts advising and approval.
4. Take your approved *Registration Form* (approvals required by your advisor, Student Life, Financial Aid, and Student Accounts) to the Registrar's Office on the appropriate date for you as noted below:
 - April 12 — seniors who will graduate in Summer 2010, Winter 2010, or Spring 2011
 - April 13 — students who have earned 60 credits or more
 - April 14 & 15 — students with fewer than 60 credits earned & other current degree seeking students

Selected Policies

Accommodations for Students with Disabilities

Students who request academic accommodations must register with and provide documentation to the Office of Disability Services. To receive accommodations, students must provide each instructor with a copy of the Office of Disability Services Accommodation Plan indicating the need and type of accommodation no later than the second week of class or its equivalent.

Admission to Major

During the semester in which 60 credit hours are earned, all students should apply for admission to their major. Failure to be admitted when 80 credit hours are earned will result in registration restrictions until admitted.

Application for Graduation

Students must apply for graduation prior to the last semester of their degree program. The application process includes a degree audit to insure all requirements will be met.

Regulations & Deadlines

It is your responsibility to be aware of and comply with all academic rules, regulations, and deadlines. A calendar for the Spring Semester is printed above. Academic rules and regulations are found in the online *2008-10 Catalog* at www.warner.edu.

Mandatory First Class Attendance

You may be dropped from any course for which you have registered if you miss during the first week of classes. If you cannot attend the first class session, you must notify the instructor *prior to the first class session*.
