## Early Registration Procedures

1. All students must see their advisor and have a signed *Registration Form* to register.
2. Take your *Registration Form* to the Student Life Office for information updates and Dean of Students approval before going to the Financial Services Office and the Registrar's Office.
3. Take your *Registration Form* to the Financial Services Office for financial aid and student accounts advising and approval.
4. Take your approved *Registration Form* (approvals required by your advisor, Student Life, Financial Aid, and Student Accounts) to the Registrar's Office on the appropriate date for you as noted below:
  - Nov. 17 — seniors who will graduate in 2010
  - Nov. 18 — students who have earned 60 hours or more
  - Nov 19 & 20 — students with fewer than 60 hours & other current degree seeking students

## Selected Policies

### Admission to Major

During the semester in which 60 credit hours are earned, all students should apply for admission to their major. Failure to be admitted when 80 credit hours are earned will result in registration restrictions until admitted.

### Application for Graduation

Students must apply for graduation prior to the last semester of their degree program. The application process includes a degree audit to insure all requirements will be met.

### Regulations & Deadlines

### Mandatory First Class Attendance
